

As part of the American Booksellers Association's ongoing efforts to focus attention on independent, locally-owned retail businesses, we commissioned a new study from the economic analysis and consultancy firm Civic Economics to serve as the first national measure of independent retail vitality nationwide.

Our goal was to build on Civic Economics' groundbreaking work in documenting the substantially greater economic impact locally-owned businesses have on their communities, research that has played an essential role in raising national awareness regarding the importance of locally-owned businesses.

In the Indie City Index, Civic Economics has created the first detailed study of independent retail vitality nationwide. The index ranks each MSA on the share of retail sales captured by independent retail businesses, provides category rankings based on such criteria as population and region, and offers an initial look at some of the most telling variables identified in the study. The report's analysis offers a new and eye-opening map of independent retail performance.

During our Advocates for Independent Retail Summit (AIR) being held in January 2011, and the months that follow, ABA hopes that this new insight on the critical role independent businesses play will help stimulate, amplify, and enrich the discussion about the indispensable contributions they make to strengthening and growing the American economy.

17 METROPOLITAN AREAS OVER 3 MILLION POPULATION






35 METROPOLITAN AREAS FROM 1 TO 3 MILLION POPULATION






50 METROPOLITAN AREAS FROM 500,000 TO 1 MILLION POPULATION






76 METROPOLITAN AREAS FROM 250,000 TO 500,000 POPULATION






## Methodology

The development of the Indie City Index proved to be a laborious and data-driven task. The goal was to identify those markets with the strongest independent retail sectors, but no dataset exists that would allow us to directly quantify independent retail sales. As a result, we chose to come at the question from the other side, looking at sales of major chain stores in each market. The idea is that by identifying a substantial portion of retail sales in each market attributable to the major chains, we would develop a gauge of chain store saturation. The flip side of that gauge, then, provides a strong indication of the relative market share of local, independent retailers.

The standard unit of study used here, the Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA or Metro), is the Census Bureau's primary classification system for urbanized and suburbanized communities. Civic Economics used the 2007 list of MSAs throughout the study, though it has changed slightly since that date.

## Data Sources

This analysis is built upon three primary data sources:

- The United States Census Bureau provided both population estimates and the regional divisions employed in this study.
- Nielsen Claritas SiteReports provided estimates for total retail sales by sector for every American Metropolitan Area. Claritas is the industry standard provider of sales and demographic data to the retail industry and related disciplines. Civic Economics has long experience with Claritas data.
- OneSource provided a complete listing of business locations and estimated sales for every chain included in developing the Index. Further discussion of that data and our approach to utilizing it is provided below.

## Sectors and Retailers Included

The Index includes every retail sector except automotive businesses and grocery stores. Automotive businesses were excluded from the dataset primarily to remove the tremendous sales volumes of car dealers which are, in the vast majority of cases, a franchise type of firm. Fuel retailers present similar characteristics. The exclusion of grocery stores was a more difficult determination. While national brands like Kroger and Safeway are easily identified, virtually every community in the nation is served as well by regional chains. In Texas markets, for example, San Antonio's H. E. Butt (HEB) controls substantial market share and a determination was made that it would not be fair to include them as a chain business while not including the many regional grocery chains that fall under \$1 billion in sales. By removing grocery stores from the dataset, we avoided the need for highly subjective determinations of degrees of locality for chains like HEB.

The next step was to identify retailers for inclusion in the dataset. Civic Economics used OneSource Business Browser to identify every American retail corporation with estimated annual sales of \$1 Billion or more. A complete listing of included retailers is included in the Data Appendix. This provided a total of 107 parent company, many of which operate multiple chain brands, ranging in size from Wal-Mart Stores to Marc Ecko. The OneSource database includes a total of 122,794 store locations operated by these corporations.

### Locations, Sales, and Accuracy

The OneSource database provided the core of our analysis. It provides a remarkably accurate list of retail locations and estimates sales at each and every location, the two attributes of interest to us in this study. However, given the magnitude of the task, it is unsurprising that the OneSource data contains errors and anomalies. In order to address those issues, Civic Economics undertook to review and clean the dataset in order to prevent incorrect data from skewing the Index values. For every retailer included, we performed the following tasks:

1. Location Review: Civic Economics scanned the dataset to identify business locations that are not customer-serving retail outlets. This review removed from the analysis hundreds of locations that serve corporate or distribution functions. Often these locations were identifiable by unusual names, addresses, or outlier sales estimates.
  - a. We removed countless locations from the database that clearly served non-retail purposes. In addition, we merged into a single location those operations that function as a single store with multiple brands within. This included shops like Best Buy and its Magnolia store within a store, or Wal-Mart's various optical, wireless, and pharmacy departments.
  - b. In thousands of cases, Civic Economics looked at maps, aerial photos, and street views from both Google and Bing to determine the type of business at a given location. Though labor intensive, this review ensured that the core database of the Index provided accurate business location data and avoided skewing results by counting business offices and distribution centers in our calculations.
2. Revenue Review: The OneSource Business Browser is designed primarily for marketing purposes. Therefore, a revenue estimate for every business location in the nation is provided, but the specific revenue number may matter less to marketers than a general understanding of the scale of the operation. Moreover, OneSource formulates revenue estimates based on proprietary methods to which we are not privileged. Thus, for each included retailer, Civic Economics performed a check of these reasonableness of these estimates.
  - a. For each chain, we compared OneSource estimates of total sales to other sources. Where total sales were too high or too low and where a definitive alternative total was available, OneSource estimates were adjusted up or down in proportion to the difference. Within each chain, we looked for outlier revenue estimates at both ends.
  - b. In some cases, the upper or lower revenue estimates were beyond reasonable. In those unusual cases, we performed a flattening of revenues to more accurately reflect what we know of the industry and of the relevant chain. For this flattening,

we identified locations that met one of two criteria: estimated sales more than three times greater than the chain's average store sales, or less than 1/3 average store sales. In these cases, quite rare at the upper end but more common at the lower, we applied a ceiling or floor for estimated revenues. As a result, in those chains subjected to this flattening, the most successful outlets are estimated to achieve sales three times the corporate average the least successful are estimated to achieve sales 1/3 of the corporate average.

Upon completion of this data cleaning, Civic Economics placed all remaining locations into a database using Microsoft Access and procured geocoding services to map every location to a specific latitude and longitude. This geocoding process allowed every location to be mapped to a specific location and assigned accurately to specific jurisdictions.

### A Measure of Chain Store Saturation

All of these locations and sales estimates above were combined at the Metropolitan level to calculate total sales achieved by the largest chains in each. The next step was to procure from Nielsen Claritas an estimate of sales in each MSA for the retail sectors included in the study. Together, they provide a measure of chain store saturation based on the prevalence and success of the major chains relative to the total sales available in the market area.

In the average case, estimated sales at the major chains represent 45.1% of all sales in the included sectors. At the high end, they represent less than 20%, and at the low end more than 80%. This range was roughly in line with our expectations based on years of study of retail economics around the nation. Moreover, the preponderance of smaller MSAs at the high and low ends also met our expectations, as the presence or absence of just one or two supercenter retailers can have a substantial impact on the composition of the local retail market.

### Indexing the Markets

The final step was to index the flipside of that measure of chain store saturation to assign higher scores to those MSAs with the lowest saturation and, thus, the highest proportion of local sales available to be captured by independent retailers. The Indie City Index is based on a hypothetical value of 100, representing an MSA with a proportion of major chain sales that exactly matches that proportion of all sales nationwide, including non-metropolitan counties.

As a final reality check on the numbers, Civic Economics had considered in advance particular communities we know well and expected to appear near the top, at the middle, or near the bottom of this measure. While there are some surprises in the final Index, we were reassured to find those particular communities falling about where we expected.
